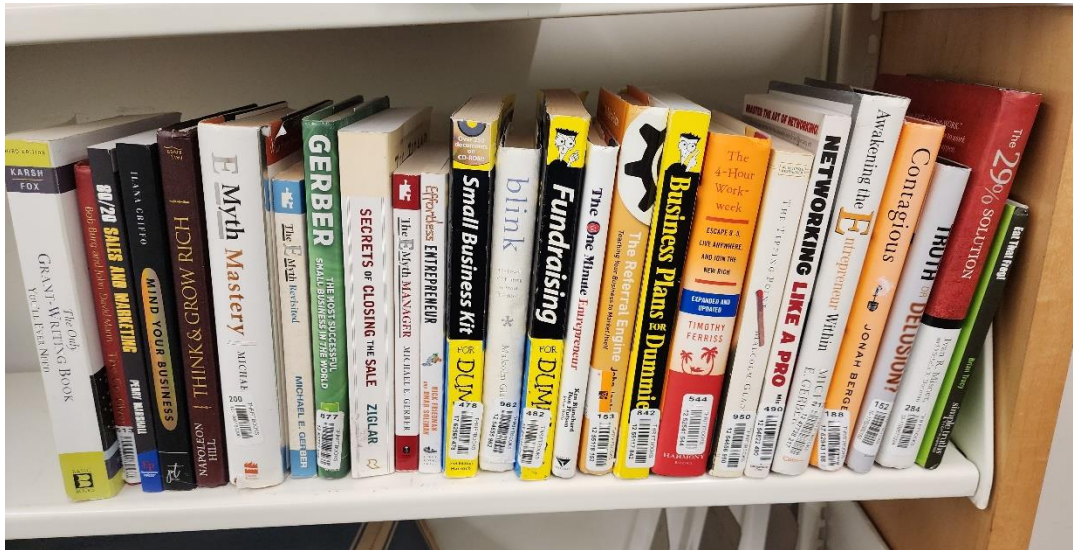
Williamson Chamber of Commerce and Williamson Library Collaborate to Create Chamber Business Resource Section
